Decisions of the EMPA Bureau of 11 June 2008 on the topics to be addressed by the EMPA Committees with a view to the recommendations to be adopted by the EMPA Plenary in March 2009

The Bureau decided that the following topics should be considered by the four committees for their reports:

Political Committee

1. Freedom of expression and respect for religious beliefs (as requested by the EMPA Plenary in March in Athens)

2. Annapolis process and its perspectives Note: Report to be submitted to the extra-ordinary plenary of the EMPA (Jordan, 12-13 October 2008)

3. Barcelona Process: Union for the Mediterranean - what value added for the development of the Mediterranean region?

Culture Committee

1. The role of the civil society for the intercultural dialogue. The inter-religious dialogue as platform for the mutual understanding in the Mediterranean

(Note: The initial subjects 1 and 3 were merged, without a specification of the new title).

2. Migrations flows as a way for regional development

Women's Rights Committee

- 1. Women: development, peace and security
- 2. Women: education, training and employment

Economic Committee

1. - Development of sustainable tourism in the Mediterranean region by means of strengthening cooperation for: training the needed human resources, supporting an increased role of private businesses and of public-private partnerships as well as for promoting our common natural and cultural heritage.

- The economic and social impact of microfinance in the Mediterranean region. (*Note: The initial subjects 1 and 3 were merged, without a specification of the new title*).

2. Rational use of water resources in the Euro-Mediterranean region and the improvement of access to safe water and adequate sanitation.

Energy and Environment ad-hoc Committe
