The meeting opened at 11.05 with Ms WALLIS in the chair.

1.

Draft agenda was adopted.

2.

The minutes had been distributed to members prior to the meeting. The minutes were approved.

Unfortunately the Commission was, due to other obligations in Brussels, unable to send a representative to brief the delegation, but Ambassador MARFURT briefed members on the Swiss "Europe 2006 report" issued on 28 June 2006. The report highlighted the EU-Switzerland relations, including the EU enlargement process. The Ambassador commented on the question of having sectorial agreements in a framework agreement, on the bilateral agreement system, and on EU membership. An item of controversy was the tax system in the Swiss cantons, where the EU was claiming that the system was not in accordance with EU rules. However, Switzerland was of the opinion that the system was in compliance with the normal free trade agreements. Ambassador MARFURT further noted that Switzerland had scheduled a referendum for 27 November 2006 on the contribution to the EU cohesion, and the referendum should hopefully have a positive outcome.

In the exchange of views that followed there were interventions from Mr RÜBIG regarding Switzerland's position to the European Union, and Mr JANOWSKI on the issue of energy/gas safety. Ms WALLIS further expressed her content with the report, but was surprised to see EEA+ as an option for Switzerland. She also stated that differentiated EU membership would only be an option *after* full membership.

Ambassador MARFURT responded to questions raised saying that EEA+ and differentiated membership were not realistic options for Switzerland. The energy questions were being discussed at the moment, and the tax system was a constitutional question, which was sacred in Switzerland.

The Chair presented the programme and the draft agenda for the next Interparliamentary Meeting, and this was followed by the nomination of first EP speakers (see Annex II). Ms BARSI-PATAKY underlined that the first European Parliament speakers should present the Parliament's policy on the different items on the agenda.

5.

At its meeting on 5 May 2006 the SINEEA delegation decided to propose to the Conference of Presidents to send an EP delegation (consisting of 5 members of the SINEEA delegation) to the EFTA Conference on "European free trade in a globalised world" in Geneva on 16-17 November 2006. However, as members of the EP Committee on International Trade had also been invited to attend the EFTA Conference, the Chair of the SINEEA delegation and the Chair of the INTA Committee, Mr Enrique BARÒN CRESPO, had made a joint proposal for authorisation of an EP delegation consisting of 6 members to attend the Conference in Geneva. Mr RÜBIG stated that he was interested in participating in the meeting in Geneva.

6.

The next EU-Switzerland Interparliamentary Meeting is scheduled to take place 10-11 July in Brussels.
