DECISIONS

The European Parliament on 18 November approved the new European Commission headed by President designate José Manuel Barroso. The new European Commission team will begin their term of office on 22 November. The European Commissioner responsible for External Relations and the European Neighbourhood Policy will be Benita Ferrero-Waldner.

MEETINGS

- ➤ HM King Abdullah II of Jordan will visit Brussels on 25 November. He will meet European Commission President José Manuel Barroso, European Commissioner for External Relations Benita Ferrero-Waldner, and Trade Commissioner Peter Mandelson, as well as the the EU High Representative Javier Solana, the President of the European Parliament Josep Borrell, and Heads of European Parliament Political Groups. The King will also be received by the Belgian King, Albert II. The meetings with EU representatives will be an opportunity to underline that EU-Jordan relations are excellent and a model of co-operation in the Mediterranean region, and to stress the importance of the European Neighbourhood Policy for the EU-Jordan partnership. EU representatives are expected to reaffirm Europe's commitment to supporting Jordan's programme of political and economic reform through the Neighbourhood Policy Action Plan and financial co-operation.
- The EU Council of Ministers meeting on 15 and 16 November in Brussels adopted guidelines on the position to be taken by the EU in the forthcoming Euro-Mediterranean meeting of Foreign Ministers scheduled for 29 and 30 November in The Hague. The meeting will take stock of progress in several areas of the Barcelona Process and relations with the Mediterranean region. It will provide an opportunity to have a political debate on the Arab-Israeli conflict. The meeting will also launch the preparation of the 10th anniversary of the Barcelona Process, which falls in November 2005.
- November in Beirut and initialled an aviation agreement. This agreement will allow all EU airlines access to the Lebanese market from any EU Member State, facilitating a further increase in trade and tourism flows between Europe and Lebanon. By bringing all existing air services agreements between Lebanon and EU Member States in line with EU law, the agreement gives all airlines flying between Lebanon and the EU the necessary legal certainty for their operations. This is the first aviation agreement between the EU and a Mediterranean Partner. The agreement paves the way for more ambitious air transport negotiations with Lebanon and other Mediterranean Partners aiming at further liberalisation of aviation markets, regulatory convergence and co-operation on key technological aspects.
- A Euro-Mediterranean Seminar on Trade and Agriculture will take place at Senior Officials' level on 23 November in Brussels as a follow-up to the meeting of Euro-Med Agriculture Ministers held last year in Venice. Discussions will cover the State of Play of Euro-Mediterranean Agreements, Future steps towards Liberalisation of Agricultural Trade, Quality Policy, Rural Development, and Prospects for future regional co-operation. Participants will be representatives of Euro-Mediterranean partners' Agriculture Ministries, the MEDA supported Euro-Mediterranean Network of Economic Institutes (FEMISE), CIHEAM (Centre international de Hautes Etudes Agronomiques Méditerranéennes), IDPM (Institute for Development Policy and Management), and the European Commission.

- The Euro-Mediterranean Committee of the Barcelona Process meeting on 11 November in Brussels approved the Draft Statute of the Anna Lindh Foundation for the Dialogue between Cultures. An informal meeting of the heads of the Foundation's National Networks took place on the same day in the same city on the Dutch Presidency's initiative. It was also attended by Advisory Committee members, the Foundation's Executive Director Traugott Schöfthaler, and European Commission representatives. Participants exchanged views on the Foundation's work programme to be prepared by Dr Schöfthaler, and various ideas were discussed. This was also an opportunity for Dr Schöfthaler to sign a contract with the European Commission's EuropeAid Cooperation Office so as to allow for launching preparatory work necessary to set up the Foundation.
- A joint meeting of the Euro-Mediterranean Committee of the Barcelona Process, the Foundation's Executive Director, the Advisory Committee, the heads of the Foundation's National Networks, and European Commission representatives was held on 12 November in Brussels. Dr Schöfthaler presented the outcome of the previous day's informal meeting (see above). The European Commission provided information on relevant MEDA funded Regional Programmes (Euromed Audiovisual, Euromed Heritage, EUMEDIS, and Euromed Youth), most of which are managed by EuropeAid Cooperation Office. The heads of the Israeli, Tunisian, Hungarian and Italian networks each presented their vision of the Foundation. Dr Schöfthaler underlined that the input from all 35 National Networks would help him finalise a 3 year work programme for the Foundation, including concrete actions for 2005, to be presented to the Ministerial meeting in the Hague later this month. Meanwhile, the Anna Lindh Foundation's Secretariat in Alexandria is launching a Call for Candidatures for 8 positions. - The meeting of the European Parliament Delegation for Relations with the Palestinian Legislative Council, scheduled for 17 November in Strasbourg, has been cancelled.

PROGRAMMES & PROJECTS

A REGIONAL EDUCATION & TRAINING PROJECT ONE STEP CLOSER TO IMPLEMENTATION

A crucial step towards implementation of the new MEDA funded 'Education and Training for Employment' Regional Project was taken on 16 November with the signing in Brussels of a contract between the European Commission's EuropeAid Cooperation Office, in charge of managing the project, and the European Training Foundation, the selected implementing body. The Education and Training project aims to support the Mediterranean Partners in the design of relevant technical and vocational education and training policies that can contribute to promoting employment through a regional approach. The project will involve a Euro-Med Forum for exchanges of experience and best practice, and a Euro-Med network on Education and Training for Employment entrusted with monitoring, information dissemination, studies, and promoting regional co-operation. Other activities will include support to self-employent and creation of micro-enterprises, as well as development of e Learning. The project is due to start in early 2005 with a € 5 million budget from MEDA. Attracting investors and building an after care strategy will be at the heart of two MEDA supported events to be held in Amman from 21 to 24 November, and in Cairo from 23 to 25 November respectively as part of the ANIMA Regional Programme (Euro-Mediterranean Network of Investment Promotion Agencies). ANIMA is designed to promote investment in the Mediterranean Partners, and managed by the European Commission's EuropeAid Cooperation Office. The Cairo event will be made

up of a 2-day Conference called 'Egypt Invest 2004' and preceded by a one-day workshop entitled "After Care – Building the country image through existing foreign investors". Egypt Invest 2004, held under the patronage of the country's Prime Minister Dr Ahmed Nazif, will focus on investment opportunities in Egypt as well as the practical steps needed to encourage further investment, modernise industry and increase foreign trade. Speakers will include the Prime Minister and several members of his government, the acting Head of the European Commission Delegation in Cairo, Oliver Nette, as well as senior decision makers from the public and private sectors, and representatives of financial institutions. The Cairo workshop will be dedicated to the after care strategies of Mediterranean Partners' Investment Promotion Agencies (IPAs). It will be organised by the Egyptian Agency (GAFI) and participants will be representatives of IPAs from Algeria, Jordan, Lebanon, Morocco, the Palestinian Territories, and Tunisia. The **Amman Local Seminar**, organised in co-operation with the Jordan Investment Board, will devote two days to Investor Targeting, focusing on IT and Pharmaceuticals, and two days to After Care. It will cover concepts, methods and best practices on project identification, as well as the design of an after care programme. http://www.animaweb.org

△ TRAINING SEMINAR FOR TRAINERS ON EURO-MED YOUTH WORK

An Introductory Training Seminar for Trainers on Euro-Mediterranean Youth Work will take place from 22 November to 3 December in Budapest within the MEDA funded Euro-Med Youth Regional Programme. It is organised by the European Youth Centre in Budapest in co-operation with the Euro-Med Salto Resource Centre and the Council of Europe. It will mark the start of a training course whose last session is scheduled for September 2006, and whose main aim is to develop the skills of 30 trainers involved in Euro-Mediterranean activities.
