The meeting opened at 15.00 with Mr. Camiel EURLINGS and Mr Oleg MOROZOV, cochairmen, jointly in the chair. Mr EURLINGS in his welcoming statement referred the successful work of the PCC in the last 7 years, before giving the floor to Mr Oleg MOROZOV for his introduction

1. Adoption of draft agenda

The draft agenda was adopted.

2. Adoption of the Minutes of the 6th EU-Russia PCC Meeting on 24-25 September 2003 in Strasbourg

The minutes were approved.

3. EU and Russian Federation: Neighbourhood and Partnership and outlook to the policies of the Partnership and Co-operation Agreement (PCA)

Statements from

- the European Commission
- the Dutch Presidency-in-Office of the Council of the European Union
- the Ambassador of the Russian Federation to the EU, on behalf of the Government of the Russian Federation

Mr EURLINGS gave the floor to Mr MINGARELLI, Director of External Affairs, on behalf of the European Commission. Mr MINGARELLI referred to the finalising preparations for the EuRussia summit in The Hague. In the last 10 years considerable progress had been made in EURussia relations due to the contributions by of the State the Duma and the European Parliament. Even close co-operation between the Russian Federation and the European Union would help to meet the challenges ahead in the field of: security, safety, terrorism and environmental issues. He commented some issues in particular: Kyoto protocol, visas, trade in nuclear material, overflight arrangements, satellite navigation and the four common areas (economic, security and justice, common neighbourhood, research and culture area), and addressed in more detail two most important issues: Kaliningrad (transit of people, transit of goods and merchandise, and economic and social developments), and Russian speaking minorities in Baltic states.

Then Mr FRATERMAN, on behalf of Dutch Presidency-in-Office of the Council of the European Union spoke about a common space on freedom, security and justice, a common neighbourhood, and research and education.

Mr PETRAKOV, Acting head of the Russian Mission to the EC, on behalf of the Government of the Russian Federation addressed the Parliamentary Co-operation Committee. In his statement he referred in particular the: four common space, rights of minorities and visas. He underlined political possibilities of the 10 new members creating a new geographical coherence that should not turn into an area of opposition. He underlined, also, the issue of visas and freedom of movement.

After this exchange of views a debate followed. Mr Vasily LIKHACHEV, Ms KREHL, and Mr PAASILINNA intervened, touching upon the following issues: Partnership co-operation agreement, neighbourhood policy, delay of the EU/Russia Summit and common values between Russia and European Union.

Mr MINGARELLI responded on partnership agreement and neighbourhood policy, Mr PETRAKOV and Mr FRATERMAN responded on the delay of the summit.

Ms MALMSTRÖM, MEP, rapporteur on EU-Russia relations underlined the importance of the ratification of the Kyoto protocol and addressed also as Human Rights issues and the progress in the common spaces.

In the following exchange Mr Vasily LIKHACHEV, Ms ZDANOKA, Mr STAES raised: the Kaliningrad issue, the space of freedom, security and justice, the rights of Russian speaking minorities in Latvia and the situation in Chechnya.

Mr MINGARELLI and PETRAKOV having responded to these points, Mr Morozov answered more indepth on Mr STAES questions and the discussion with the moderate element in Chechnya.

In the following discussion Mr ILVES, Mr KELAM, Ms ANDRIKIENE, Mr BELOUSOV, Mr LAX, Mr LANDSBERGIS, MR Alexey LIKHACHEV raised: EU-Russia relations and the new member states, the 4 spaces, Chechnya, refugee camps, the fight against terrorism, Russian speakers in the Baltic area as a linguistic minority, safety and terrorism, and an interparliamentary dialogue between the Duma and the European Parliament.

Mr MOROZOV, Mr MINGARELLI, Mr FRATERMAN and Mr PETRAKOV concluded point 3 of the agenda.

Mr EURLINGS concluded by saying that the EU had entered in a new era with 10 new countries 8 of which are former members of the former Soviet Union, whereas a new Russian Federation is going ahead into a new future, getting stronger in many aspects

As for the Duma Statement of 26 October 2004, Mr EURLINGS proposed to discuss the situation in: Kaliningrad, the situation of the Russian speaking minorities, and the border issues.

Vasily LIKHACHEV introduced the Kaliningrad topic, referring to differing informations from European Commission and Russian authorities. He underlined in depth the transit problems and pointed towards the States of Duma's criticism with regard to the situation.

Then Mr LATTI stated the commission. He touched on the issue of transit of goods proposing a less complicated and costly administrative procedure should be easier.

Followed comments by Ms ANDRIKIENE, Mr PALECKIS, Mr GEREMEK and Mr KELAM referring to: a strong strategic partnership, regional development, a computerised system, rate of

goods traffic, social and economical development in region, a proposition to visit Kaliningrad, transfer structure of goods (by trains, by road, by sea)

Mr EURLINGS and Mr Vasily LIKHACHEV concluded the exchange on the Kaliningrad issue.

Mr BELOUSOV introduced the issue of the Russian speaking minorities in the EU, followed by Mr LATTI for the European Commission.

Intervened Ms ZDANOKA, Mr TABAJDI, Mr LANDSBERGIS, Mr MOROZOV, MR KELAM and Mr Alexey LIKHACHEV on: the Russian speaking minority in Latvia and Estonia, a "working group" to be created on these issues.

Mr LATTI led into the debate on border questions. Followed Mr KELAM, Mr LAX, Mr Alexey LIKHACHEV, Mr MOROZOV, Mr LANDSBERGIS all agreeing that the border problems should be resolved as fast as possible

Mr EURLINGS concluded that "working groups" should be created on the issue of Kaliningrad and Estonia/Latvia-Russia border problems and proposed to deal in a joint debate with the issues of Terrorism and North Caucasus,

Mr GORBUNOV, MR STAES, Mr SAFARALIEV, Mr SAVELIEV and Mr LANDSBERGIS touched on: the help for the victims of terrorism, the Beslan tragedy, the fighting of radical organisations, and political situation in Chechnya and possible solution

Mr EURLINGS concluding this exchange by expressing: there are no excuses for terrorism and it's a challenge to fight the terrorism with judiciary co-operation while keeping our society open and democratic

Mr GORBUNOV took the floor for his presentation on 60th anniversary of the end of the Second World War

MR KELAM, Mr SEVASTIYANOV, Mr PETERLE, Mr KOVALEV, Ms KREHL, Mr LIBERADZKI, Ms ZDANOKA, Mr LANDSBERGIS intervened.

Mr EURLINGS, Mr GORBUNOV and Mr MOROZOZ gave the conclusion on the two day meeting.

At the end, Mr BUSQUIN gave a brief comment on the common space in the economy.

5. Adoption of joint statement

After some changes the joint statement was adopted.
