The meeting opened at 11.40 a.m. with the Chairwoman, Mrs Rudi Ubeda, in the chair.

1. Adoption of draft agenda (PE 379.193)

The draft agenda was adopted.

2. Approval of minutes of the meeting of 4 October 2006 (PE 379.180)

The minutes were approved.

3. Chairwoman's announcements

The Chairwoman informed members of the following:

- On 12 December, two new <u>agreements</u> had been signed <u>between the EU and Morocco</u>. The first, concerning aviation, replaced all the bilateral aviation agreements between Member States and Morocco. It not only opened up markets but was also designed to approximate the legislation of the two parties. The agreement would stimulate the growth of traffic to Morocco, and new, additional and more varied scheduled services had already been announced. The cooperation agreement on GALILEO covered a large number of areas of cooperation, including joint activities in the field of scientific research and training, industrial cooperation, trade and market development, standards, certification and regulatory measures.
- The European Commissioner for justice, freedom and security, Mr Franco Frattini, had stated at a conference held on 21 November in Lisbon, that <u>immigration</u> was a transnational phenomenon which called for a transnational and global answer.
- At the first high-level Conference on <u>Migration</u> and Development, held in <u>Tripoli on 22 and 23 November</u>, the EU and the African States agreed to cooperate in a concrete manner in the field of migration. The Conference had adopted a joint Africa-European Union declaration on migration and development and an action plan to combat trafficking in human beings. Those documents would form the basis for cooperation between the EU and Africa in the coming years, and would bolster the efforts made by the EU to strengthen political dialogue with Africa on migration and development issues.

- Situation in Tunisia

The Chairwoman had received a letter stating that Mme Abou, the wife of Maitre Mohamed Abou, who had been in prison for some time, had been attacked near Tunis jail. Her attackers had been wearing civilian clothes.

Mr Hutchinson announced that the Tunisian journalist Lotfi Haiji had been arrested the previous day. It had been decided to send in an e-mail to members a draft text protesting the conduct of the Tunisian authorities. Given the agreements that existed between Tunisia and the EU, the attention of the EC should be drawn to what was going on.

- Sentencing to death of the Bulgarian nurses and a Palestinian doctor

The Chairwoman informed the members that she had just learnt via the media that the Bulgarian nurses and Palestinian doctor detained in Libya since 1999 had been sentenced to death, despite the presence of several experts. All the expert reports pointed to the children having contracted the AIDS virus as a result of poor hygiene conditions at the hospital. The children had been infected before the arrival of the Bulgarian nurses and the Palestinian doctor.

Simon Busuttil pointed out that the agenda of the December 2006 plenary session had included a resolution on Libya, but he had asked for that item to be deferred as the timing was inappropriate given that a key stage was being approached in the legal process.

He also informed the members that an ad hoc EP delegation had been sent to Libya to look into the issue of illegal immigration. He had sent a letter to the Conference of Presidents asking for authorisation for this work to continue, which he said it would be more difficult to obtain now that the sentenced had been passed.

The following spoke: Luis Yañez-Barnuevo García, Simon Busuttil, Francesco Musotto and Bogusław Sonik. At the end of this discussion it was decided to send a letter to the President of the EP expressing the Delegation's concerns over the fate of those sentenced.

4. Oral report oral by Mr Hutchinson, Chair of the ad hoc ad hoc delegation for the observation of the legislative elections in Mauritania, on the conduct of the elections

Alain Hutchinson said that it had been difficult to form the ad hoc delegation responsible for observation of the elections in Mauritania, and that it had only comprised 3 members. He stated that the Mauritanian authorities had honoured their undertakings. The elections had gone very smoothly. There had been three separate ballot papers for the legislative, regional and municipal elections.

There had been a very high turnout of around 80%. Calm had reigned during the elections

and both the polling stations and electoral equipment had been well organised.

The delegation had met all the political and association representatives. However, it was hard to tell what the proportion of Islamic representatives would be. This would be known when the composition of the Assembly was decided.

The Presidential election would be held on 3 and 21 March 2007. Mr Hutchinson hoped he would be able to return with an EP delegation as the current President would have to hand over to a democratically-elected President and that election would also be decisive.

5. Exchange of views on the Delegation's activities for 2007

A calendar of the Delegation's activities for 2007 was distributed at the meeting. The Chairwoman informed members of the activities planned for 2007:

b) the following Interparliamentary meetings were planned:

•	24 - 25 October	- visit of a Mauritanian delegation to Strasbourg

Simon Busuttil said that a meeting with Libya could be added as none had been programmed for either Brussels or Strasbourg.

The Chairwoman indicated that it would be difficult to hold a meeting with Libya in 2007 as the programme of activities for 2007 had already been adopted by the Conference of Presidents, in December 2006.

The Chairwoman asked members to inform her of the matters they wished to address at the various meetings.

The following spoke on the content of the programme of activities: Messrs Busuttil, Hutchinson and Yañez-Barnuevo. Following this discussion, it was decided:

- to invite the Commission's desk officer for Libya to the next meeting;
- to hold a debate on the issue of Western Sahara, inviting to this representatives of Morocco, Algeria, Polisario and the United Nations.

6. Date and place of next meeting

The next meeting of the Delegation would probably be held in Brussels on 24 January 2007, from 4.15 to 5.15 p.m. .
