Challenges for organizing out-of-country voting for Ukraine

Lack of clarity

- When will the war end up?
- How many people will be residing abroad?
- In which countries Ukrainian voters will reside by the date of election?

Legal challenges

- Whether it is possible to open polling stations outside of the embassies or organize mobile polling stations in other countries?
- Whether Verkhovna Rada of Ukraine will adopt changes to the Electoral Code well in advance to allow for preparations?
- Whether selected model for out-of-country voting will require changes to the Constitution?

Organizational challenges

- Additional or mobile polling stations: voter registration, premises, delivering materials, ballot papers, hiring and training election officials, voter education, counting and tabulation of results
- Postal voting: voter registration, arranging postal services, producing electoral materials, voter education, counting and tabulation of results
- E-voting: voter registration, software development, cybersecurity, voter education, time for piloting and testing
