Terms of use of the European Parliament logo

The European Parliament logo is intended for use on Parliament's own documents, or documents distributed with its agreement. It can also be used on any other document relating to or devoted to the European Parliament, subject to compliance with the Graphics Guide. However, the European Parliament reserves the right to prohibit the use of its logo in cases where such use would prejudice its interests or be inappropriate.

The use of the European Parliament logo is authorised provided that:

- such use is related to the context of the European Parliament,
- such use is not linked directly or indirectly to a commercial purpose,
- such use is in no way associated with data or information that is of a racist, anti-Semitic, xenophobic, revisionist, defamatory, insulting, obscene, pornographic or paedophile nature or tending to incite violence, especially racial violence; likely by its vary nature to undermine respect for the dignity of the human being, equal rights of women and men and the protection of children and adolescents; inviting minors to commit illicit or dangerous acts; encouraging others to commit crimes or offences or to consume prohibited substances; inciting suicide; inciting discrimination or hatred of a person or a group of persons on grounds of their origin, membership or non-membership of an ethnic group, a nation, a group, or a specific race or religion; excusing certain crimes (in particular, murder, rape, war crimes and crimes against humanity); contrary to public policy or to accepted principles of morality.

In all cases, the European Parliament reserves the right to prohibit the use of its logo in any circumstances where this use might be harmful to it or of an inappropriate nature.

The use of this logo without an objection being expressed by the European Parliament shall not imply Parliament's agreement to such use nor shall it imply any endorsement or sponsorship by Parliament of such use.

The European Parliament's logo is a protected original design. All rights are reserved. It may not be registered as a trademark or for any other purpose. The use of the logo by third parties, even with Parliament's consent, does not confer any rights over the logo.
