The Hon. Zha Peixin



Member of the Standing Committee of the 11th National People's Congress (NPC) and Vice-Chairman of NPC Foreign Affairs Committee since March 2008;

Born in Jiangsu Province in 1946 and graduated from Beijing Foreign Studies University in 1972.

From 1972 to 1973, Mr. Zha served as Staff member of the China's Permanent Mission to UN. From 1973 to 1978, he was Staff member of the Liaison Office of China to U.S. From 1979 to 1986, he served as Deputy Division Chief of the Department of North America and Oceania Affairs of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MFA). From 1986 to 1990, he worked as Deputy director-general of Department of North America and Oceania Affairs of MFA. From 1990 to 1993, Mr. Zha served as Minister Counselor of Chinese Embassy to Canada. From 1993 to 1996, he was Director-general of Department of Policy Planning of the Foreign Affairs Office of the State Council. From 1996 to 1998, he was Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary to Canada. From 1998 to 2002, he served as Vice-Minister of the Foreign Affairs Office of the Central Committee of the Communist Party of China. From 2002 to 2007, Mr. Zha served as Ambassador to U.K. In 2007, he served as Vice-President of CPIFA.

The Hon. Qi Xuchun



Member of the Standing Committee and Vice-Chairman of the Foreign Affairs Committee of the 11th National People's Congress (NPC) since March 2008; Vice-Chairman of the Central Committee of the Revolutionary Committee of the Chinese Kuomintang.

Born in Beijing in 1946. He graduated from Peking University with a bachelor's degree.

He used to work as Vice President of Chengde County, Vice Chairman of Chengde Municipal People's Political Consultative Conference and later Deputy Major of Chengde City. Since 2000, Mr. Qi held the positions of Deputy Secretary-General of Chinese People's Political Consultative Conference and Vice-Chairman of Central Committee of Revolutionary Committee of the Chinese Kuomintang.

The Hon. Mu Benli



Born in Gansu in May 1946. He graduated from Gansu Teachers' University with a bachelor's degree.

Vice Chairman of the Ethnic Minorities Committee of the 11th National People's Congress (NPC) since March 2008. Prior to that served as Vice-Chairman of the National Nationalities Affairs Committee of China.

Born in Sichuan in 1944. He graduated from the Chinese Academy of Social Sciences, PHD.

Member of the Standing Committee and the Financial and Economic Affairs Committee of the 11th National People's Congress (NPC) since March 2008; Vice Present of the Chinese Academy of Social Sciences.
