Vladimir Voronin was born at 25 May in 1941 in Corjova, a village near Chisinau.

In 1961 Mr. V. Voronin graduated the Chisinau Technical Cooperative College, and in 1971 – the Soviet Union's Institute of Alimentary Industry;

In 1983 he graduated the Academy of Sciences of the Central Committee of the Soviet Union Communist Party, and in 1991 the Academy of Police of URSS;

By profession he is - engineer-economist, politician and lawyer.

He began his professional activity in 1961, in the village of Criuleni, as Director of breadfactory. Since 1966 until 1971 he was Director of Dubasari's bread-factory.

In the next ten years Mr. V. Voronin worked in State's public service: in district's executive committees of Dubasari and Ungheni, and in Executive Committee of the City of Ungheni.

Since 1983 until 1985 he was inspector and Deputy-head of Organizational Department of Communist Party's Central Committee of the Soviet Socialist Republic of Moldova (SSRM).

During 1985 Mr. V. Voronin was the Chief of the Department of the Council of Ministries of SSRM. Since 1985 until 1989 - First Secretary of Communist's Party Committee of the City of Bender. In 1989 and 1990 he held the position of Minister of Internal Affairs of SSRM.

In 1993 he was elected co-President of Communist's Party Organizational Committee of the Republic of Moldova. In 1994 was elected Prime Secretary of Communist Party's Central Committee of the Republic of Moldova.

Since 1998 until 2001 - Member in the Parliament of Republic of Moldova, member of the permanent bureau of the Parliament, President of parliamentary group of the Communist Party of the Republic of Moldova.

In April 2001 was elected President of the Republic of Moldova.

After the Parliamentary elections from 6 of March 2005 Mr. V. Voronin has been re-elected, for the second term, as President of the Republic of Moldova, being invested in this function at April 6th 2005.
